## How to Make Your Zine!

1. Make a double-sided copy of the file.
2. Use a pair of scissors or xacto-knife to carefully make a slit along the blue line running down the center of the paper.
3. Use the blue dots as your fold lines. Fold the paper carefully in half lengthwise/vertically and crease it. Then fold the paper in half widthwise/horizontally, and then in half again. You have now made all the folds.
4. Holding the folded paper lengthwise with the slit facing up, and using your thumb and forefinger at each end, push the sides toward the middle, causing the two sides to bend outwards like a tunnel and forming an "X." Now you can crease them and you will see the front and the back page, and fold it into a little book!
5. When you want to view the opposite side, just fold it over the other way and crease the paper in that direction.

Now you have a zine that you can work with! I hope you have fun!
